

MAN THREATENS TO BURN HOUSE DOWN

A PLYMOUTH COUNTY MAN WAS ARRESTED YESTERDAY AFTER THREATENING TO BURN A HOUSE DOWN.

SHERIFF'S OFFICIALS WERE SENT TO 33617 K18S, JUST NORTH OF SIOUX CITY AT 3:49 P.M. FOR A DOMESTIC COMPLAINT.

WHILE RESPONDING, DEPUTIES WERE ADVISED THAT 25 YEAR OLD NICOLAS ISAC GANZALEZ HAD A FEMALE AND A 4 YEAR OLD MALE IN THE HOUSE AND WAS THREATENING TO BURN IT DOWN IF HE SAW OFFICERS APPROACHING.

GONZALEZ WAS LOCATED IN A VEHICLE THAT WAS TRYING TO LEAVE THE PROPERTY.

HE WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AND CHARGED WITH THREAT OF EXPLOSIVE OR INCENDIARY DEVICE, A CLASS D FELONY AND DOMESTIC ABUSE/ASSAULT A SERIOUS MISDEMEANOR.

K18S WAS CLOSED FOR ROUGHLY AN HOUR WHILE OFFICERS WERE ON THE SCENE.
